

JOE DIMAGGIO CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL EXPANSION Hollywood, Florida



Project

CGA has provided a wide range of services in support of this major hospital expansion since the earliest stages. To date, CGA has provided technical guidance in the creation of the Hospital District zoning approval by the City of Hollywood and has provided expertise in the submittal of the project for City site plan review. Once completed, the project will provide over 150,000 square feet of new pediatric hospital facilities that will be connected to the existing hospital via a pedestrian bridge over North 35th Avenue.

In addition, the new hospital is planned to be a LEED Certified project. CGA is working closely with the building architects and local consultants to analyze and track the potential LEED credits for the overall project. Specifically, CGA is researching the various options for maximizing the water efficiency credits through the use of rain-water collection and underground cisterns as well as bringing the City's reclaimed water lines to the site for irrigation purposes. CGA is also providing expertise and analysis of several other site and civil engineering related LEED credit items. The design of the site lighting for both the building and the adjacent streetscape shall also be energy efficient, possibly incorporating LED lights and the latest technology.

In total, the services that CGA will provide in support of this project will include planning, surveying, traffic engineering, civil engineering, landscape architecture, and electrical engineering.
