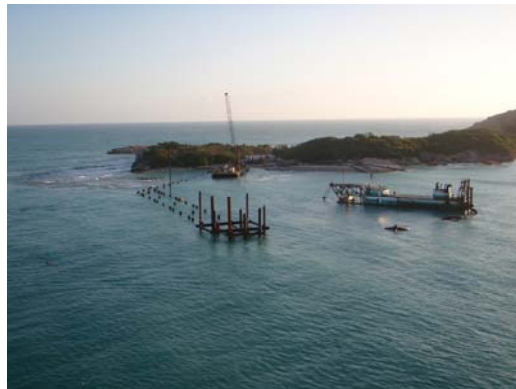

CGA was contracted by Orion Dredging Services to perform a pre-dredge survey and post-dredge survey in reference to a new ship dock in Labadee, Haiti.

Labadee is a "private island" resort leased by Royal Caribbean International, which is a private beach just off a peninsula in the mainland of Haiti. Currently Royal Caribbean International uses the port which allows only for ships to anchor offshore and passengers must take a ferry from the ship to the main land. The goal of the project is to locate and confirm control monuments, acquire hydrographic and topographic field data to develop at location for a permanent docking site for the cruise ships. The areas subject to the effort include four specific locations where dredging will take place and two specific areas that are to be used as dredge material disposal sites.
